## MS Edge

You can use Microsoft Edge to run in IE Mode. To do this follow these steps:

- Go to the Default browser options in the Settings section (click on the ... at the end of the address bar and select settings, or copy this "edge://settings/defaultBrowser" into the address bar and press Enter
- Add <u>https://infor.nextfifteen.co.uk</u> to the Internet Explorer Mode page. As the page expires monthly, you will need to add this back each month
